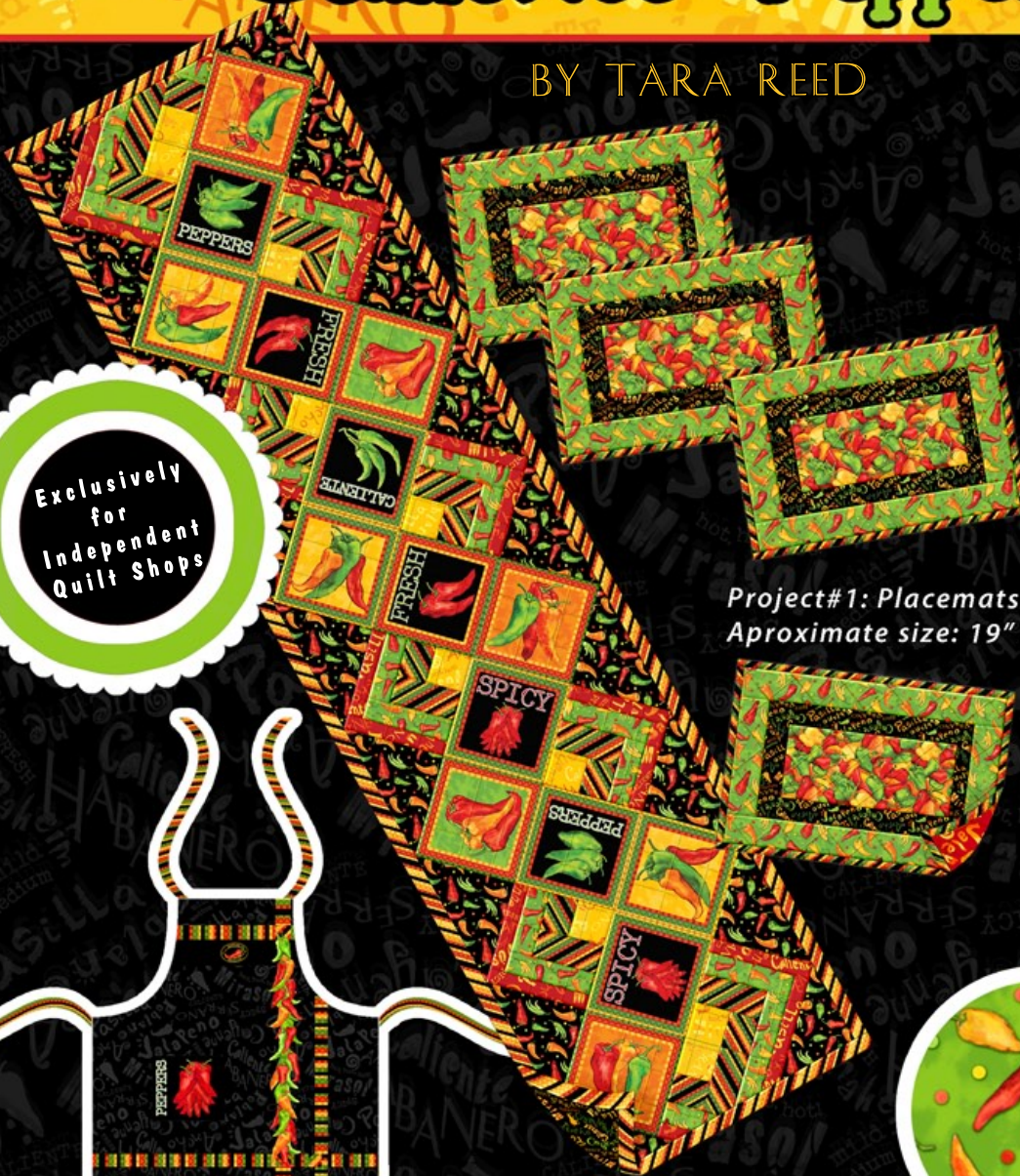

Caliente Peppers

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

Table Runner Instructions approximate size: 22" x 82"

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - cut 15 - 7 1/2" x 7 1/2" squares (center designs evenly)

Fabric C - cut 4 - 2" strips, subcut 10 - 2" x 5" and 10 - 2" x 6 1/2"

Fabric D - cut 2 - 11 1/4" strips, subcut 4 - 11 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions for 14 side triangles ☒

cut 2 - 6" x 6" squares, cut in half diagonally for 4 corner triangles ☒

Fabric E - Borders - cut 6 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end for 1 long strip, then subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 80 1/2" and 2 - 1 1/2" x 22 1/2" (exact length may vary so measure YOUR quilt.)

Fabric F - cut 1 - 2 1/2" strip and cut 2 - 2 1/2" strips, subcut 10 - 2 1/2" x 5"

Fabric G - cut 4 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 10 - 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" and 10 - 1 1/2" x 7 1/2"

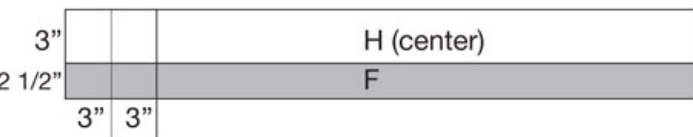
Fabric H - cut 1 - 3" strip

Fabric I - Backing - cut 1 - 22 1/2" x 82 1/2" (or exact size of your table runner)

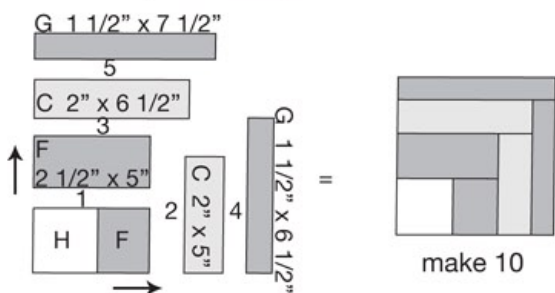
Thin Batting - cut 1 - 22 1/2" x 82 1/2"

2. Piecing Order:

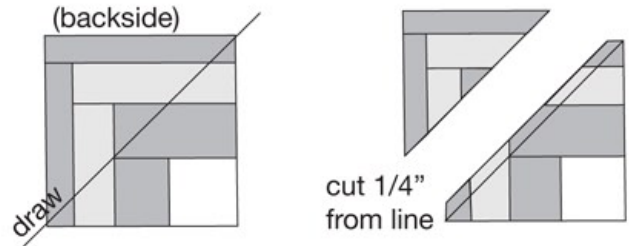
1. First, sew **H** 3" and **F** 2 1/2" strips side by side. Press toward **F**. Subcut 10 - 3" segments.



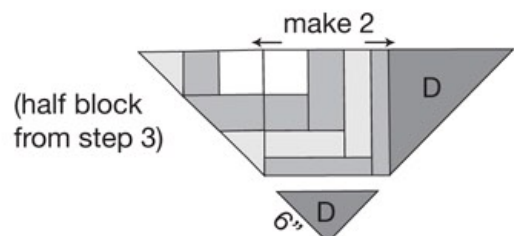
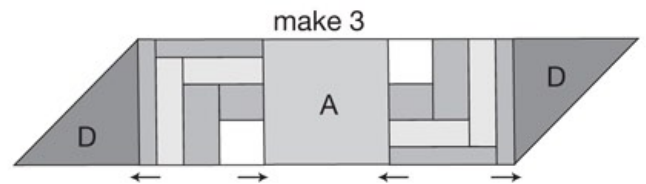
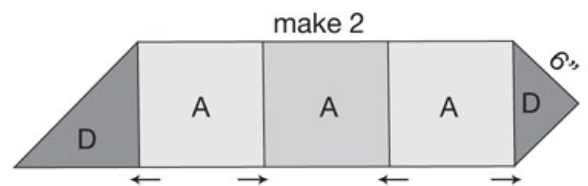
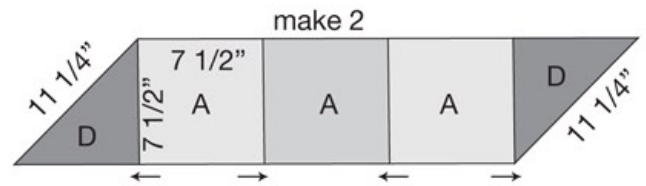
2. Next, sew logs (rectangles) to the center in the numerical order as listed in the diagram. Press each log away from the center square **H** before adding the next log. Make 10 - 7" finished (7 1/2" unf.) blocks.



3. Draw a diagonal line on the backside of two blocks, then cut 1/4" outside the drawn line for two side setting triangles.



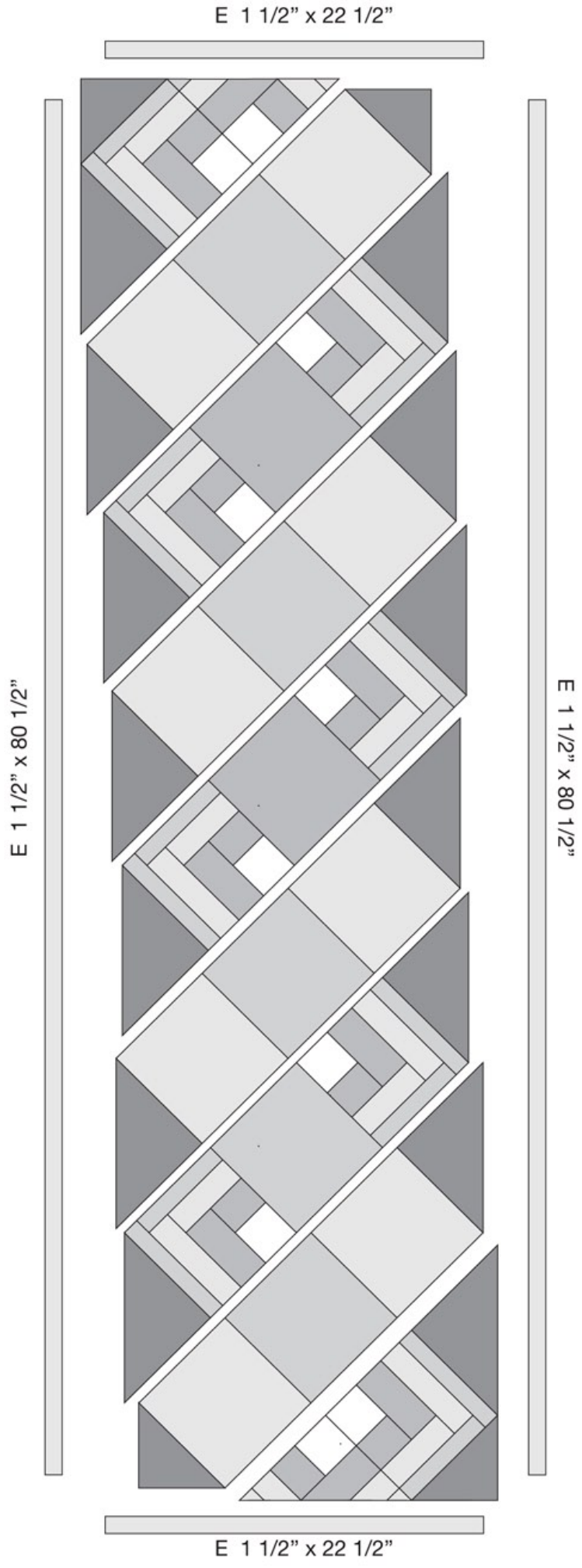
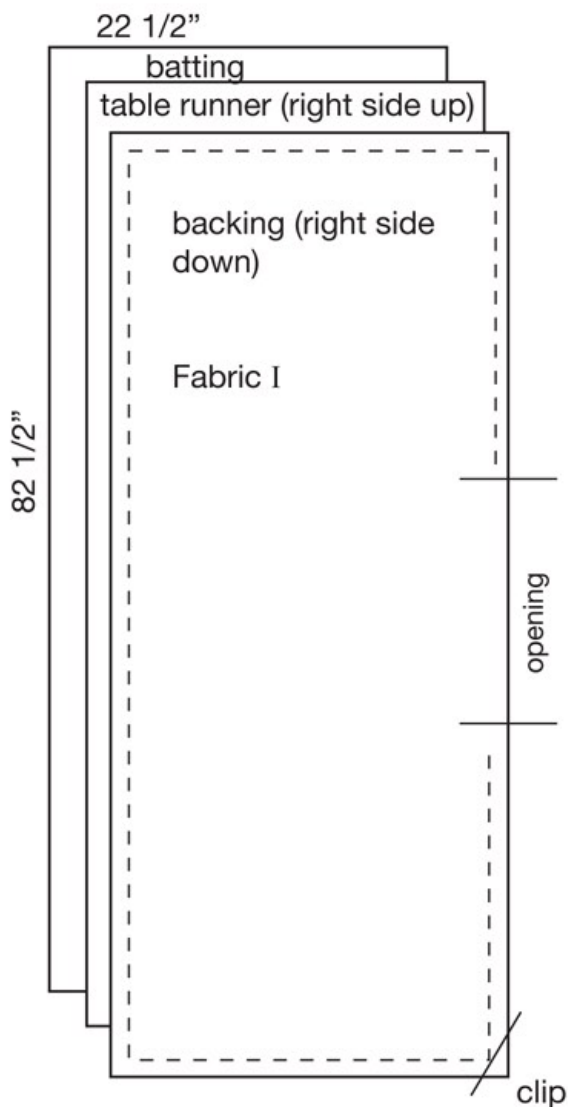
4. Sew rows of **A** blocks, pieced blocks and setting triangles together according to the diagrams. See colored picture for orientation of **A** blocks. Arrows indicate pressing directions.



5. Sew table runner together by diagonal rows according to the diagram.

6. Sew **E 1 1/2"** borders around the table runner, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders.

7. Finishing the table runner: Layer batting, table runner (right side up), backing (right side down). Match raw edges and secure with pins. Stitch 1/4" around table runner, leaving approximately 12" open for turning. Clip corners and turn right sides out. Press. Stitch opening closed. Topstitch 1/4" around edge of table runner to create faux binding. Add optional quilting and enjoy!!



Placemat Instructions (Set of 4)

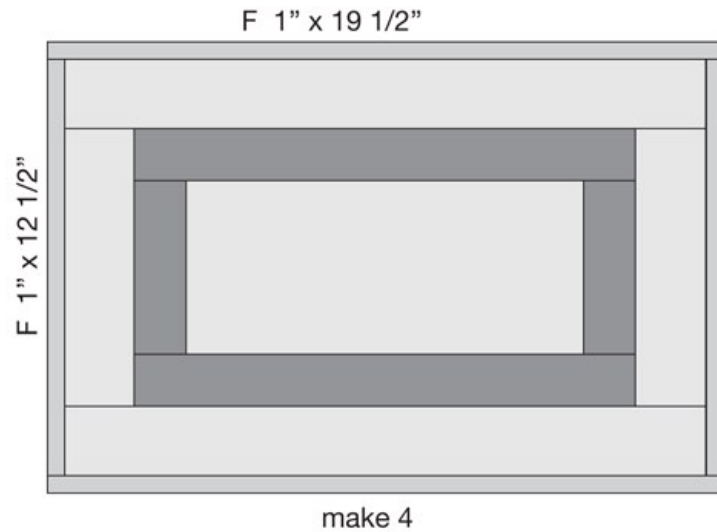
approximate size: 13" x 19" each

3. Sew **F** 1" borders around placemats, sides first, then top and bottom borders.

1. Cut the following:

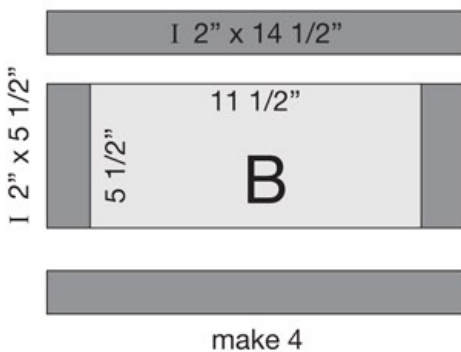
- Fabric B** - cut 2 - 5 1/2" strips, subcut 4 - 5 1/2" x 11 1/2"
Fabric C - cut 6 - 2 1/2" strips, subcut 8 - 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" and 8 - 2 1/2" x 18 1/2"
Fabric F - cut 7 - 1" strips, subcut 8 - 1" x 12 1/2" and 8 - 1" x 19 1/2"
Fabric G - Backing - cut 2 - 13 1/2" strips, subcut 4 - 13 1/2" x 19 1/2"
Fabric I - cut 6 - 2" strips, subcut 8 - 2" x 5 1/2" and 8 - 2" x 14 1/2"

Thin batting - cut 4 - 13 1/2" x 19 1/2"



2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew **I** 2" borders around center **B**, sides first, then top and bottom borders according to the diagram. Make 4.



4. Finishing the placemats: Layer batting, placemat (right side up), backing (right side down). Match raw edges and secure with pins. Stitch 1/4" around each placemat, leaving approximately 8" open for turning. Clip corners and turn right side out. Press. Stitch opening closed. Topstitch 1/4" around edge of each placemat to create faux binding. Add optional quilting and enjoy!!

2. Sew **C** 2 1/2" borders around center, sides first, then top and bottom borders.
